

Professor Details Making of Wine

Dr. Frank Gadek, an associate professor in the chemistry department at Allentown College of St. Francis de Sales, this week outlined the procedures of winemaking during a lecture at the college on "The Science of Enology."

He told about 75 persons attending that enology is the technical name for winemaking. He explained that, in 1972, wine was made in about 250,000 homes in the United States and estimated that almost \$25 million was spent on winemaking kits during the Christmas season.

Gadek announced that a prospective winemaking course is being planned at the college. Anyone interested in joining is to contact him at the college.
